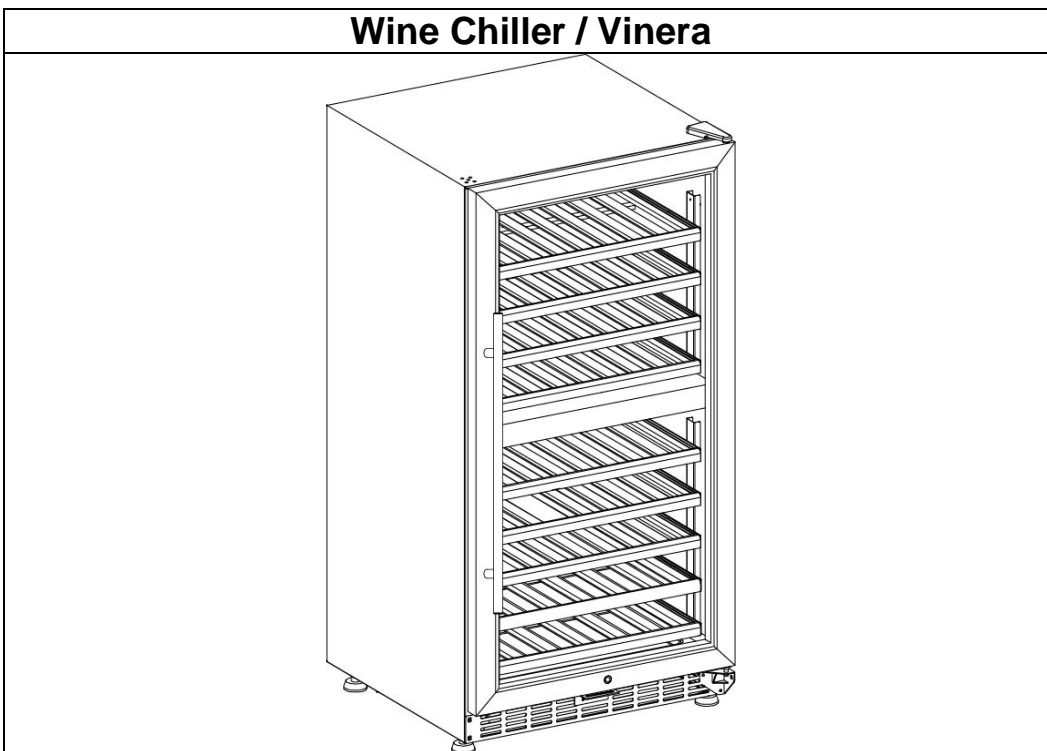

Before the appliance is used, it must be properly positioned and installed as described in this manual, so read the manual carefully. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury when using the appliance, follow basic precaution, including the following:

DANGER

- Plug into a grounded 3-prong outlet, do not remove grounding prong, do not use an adapter, and do not use an extension cord.
- Replace all panels before operating.
- It is recommended that a separate circuit, serving only your appliance be provided. Use receptacles that cannot be turned off by a switch or pull chain.
- Never clean appliance parts with flammable fluids. These fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion. And do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance. The fumes can create a fire hazard or explosion.
- Before proceeding with cleaning and maintenance operations, make sure the power line of the unit is disconnected.
- Do not connect or disconnect the electric plug when your hands are wet.
- Unplug the appliance or disconnect power before cleaning or servicing. Failure to do so can result in electrical shock or death.
- Do not attempt to repair or replace any part of your appliance unless it is specifically recommended in this material. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.

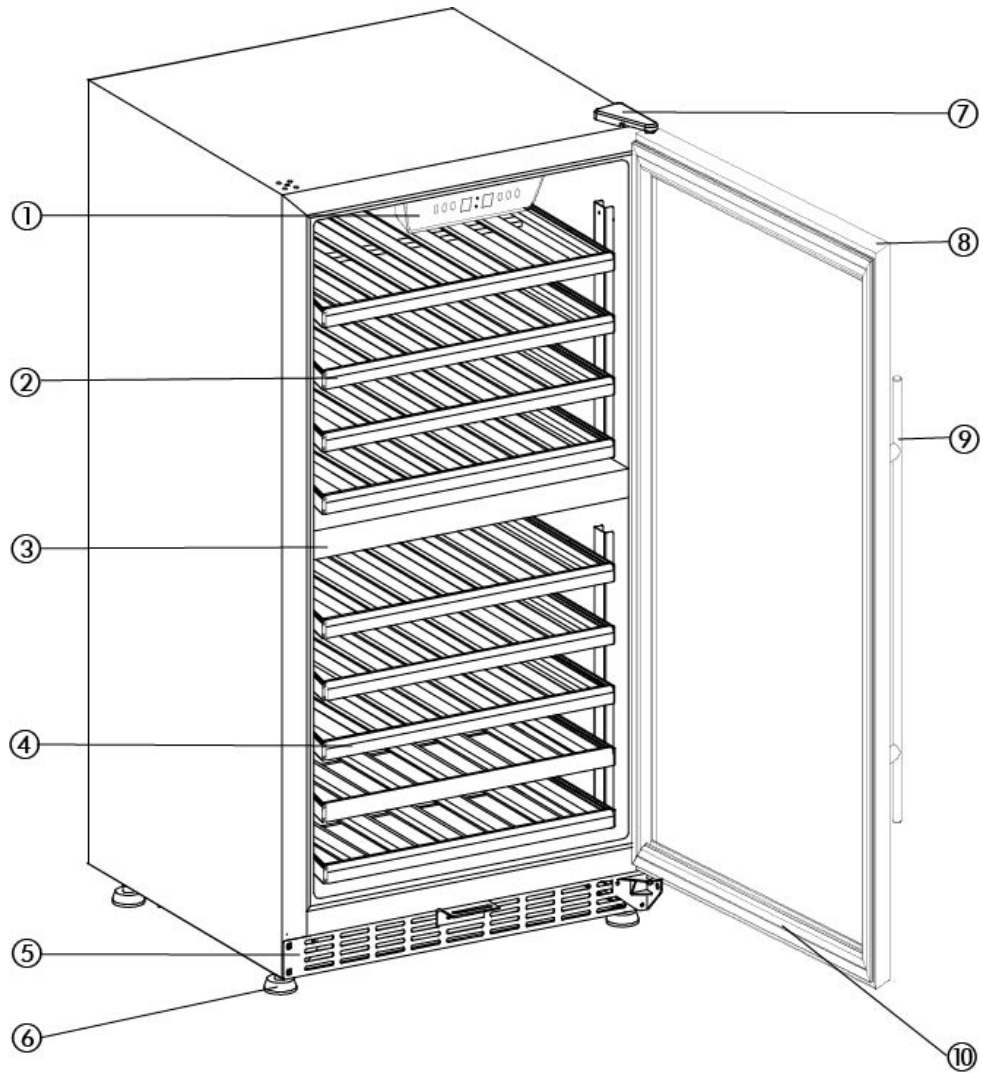

ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

⚡ Warning ⚡

Improper use of the grounded plug can result in the risk of electrical shock. If the power cord is damaged, have it replaced by an authorized Avanti Products service center.

This appliance should be properly grounded for your safety. The power cord of this appliance is equipped with a three-prong plug which mates with standard three prong wall outlets to minimize the possibility of electrical shock.

Do not under any circumstances cut or remove the third ground prong from the power cord supplied. For personal safety, this appliance must be properly grounded.

This appliance requires a standard 115/120 Volt AC ~/60Hz electrical ground outlet with three-prong. Have the wall outlet and circuit checked by a qualified electrician to make sure the outlet is properly grounded. When a standard 2-prong wall outlet is encountered, it is your responsibility and obligation to have it replaced with a properly grounded 3-prong wall outlet.

The cord should be secured behind the appliance and not left exposed or dangling to prevent accidental injury.

The appliance should always be plugged into its own individual electrical outlet which has a voltage rating that matches the rating label on the appliance. This provides the best performance and also prevent overloading house wiring circuits that could cause a fire hazard from overheated. Never unplug the appliance by pulling the power cord. Always grip the plug firmly and pull straight out from the receptacle. Repair or replace immediately all power cords that have become frayed or otherwise damaged. Do not use a cord that shows cracks or abrasion damage along its length or at either end. When moving the appliance, be careful not to damage the power cord.

➤ **EXTENSION CORD**

Because of potential safety hazards under certain conditions, it is strongly recommended that you do not use an extension cord with this appliance. However, if you must use an extension cord it is absolutely necessary that it be a UL/CUL-Listed, 3-wire grounding type appliance extension cord having a grounding type plug and outlet and that the electrical rating of the cord be 115 volts and at least 10 amperes.

➤ **SURGE PROTECTOR**

Most electrical appliances use a series of electric control boards to operate. These boards are very susceptible to power surges and could be damaged or destroyed.

If the appliance is going to be used in an area or if your city / country is prone to power surges / outages; it is suggested that you use a power surge protector for all electrical devices / appliances you use. The surge protector that you select must have a surge block high enough to protect the appliance it is connected to. If you have any questions regarding the type and size of surge protector needed contact a licensed electrician in your area.

Damages due to power surges are not considered a manufacturer covered defect and will void your product warranty.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

➤ **BEFORE USING YOUR WINE CHILLER**

- Remove the exterior and interior packing.
- Check to be sure you have all of the following parts:

1	Instruction Manual
7	Large Shelves
2	Short Shelf
2	Keys
1 Set	Hinges for Door Swing Reversal
2	Hinge Screw Caps
1	Stainless Steel Handle

- Before connecting this appliance to the power source, let it stand upright for approximately 2 hours. This will reduce the possibility of a malfunction in the cooling system from handling during transportation.
- Clean the interior surface with lukewarm water using a soft cloth.

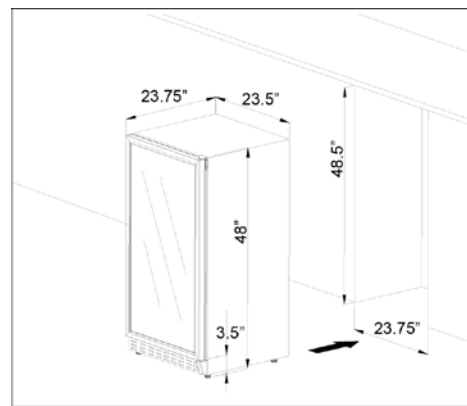
➤ **INSTALLATION OF YOUR WINE CHILLER**

- This appliance is designed to be for free standing installation or built-in (fully recessed).
- Place your Wine Chiller on a floor that is strong enough to support it when it is fully loaded. To level your Wine Chiller, adjust the front leveling legs at the bottom of the Wine Chiller.
- Locate the Wine Chiller away from direct sunlight and sources of heat (stove, heater, radiator, etc.). Direct sunlight may affect the acrylic coating and heat sources may increase electrical consumption. Extreme cold ambient temperatures may also cause the unit not to perform properly.
- Avoid locating the unit in moist areas.
- Plug the Wine Chiller into an exclusive, properly installed-grounded wall outlet. Do not under any circumstances cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord. Any questions concerning power and/or grounding should be directed toward a certified electrician or an authorized Avanti Products service center.

➤ **BUILT – IN CABINET INSTRUCTIONS**

This unit is designed for both built-in or free standing installation. If you plan to use this unit in a built-in application please follow the requirements shown to the right.

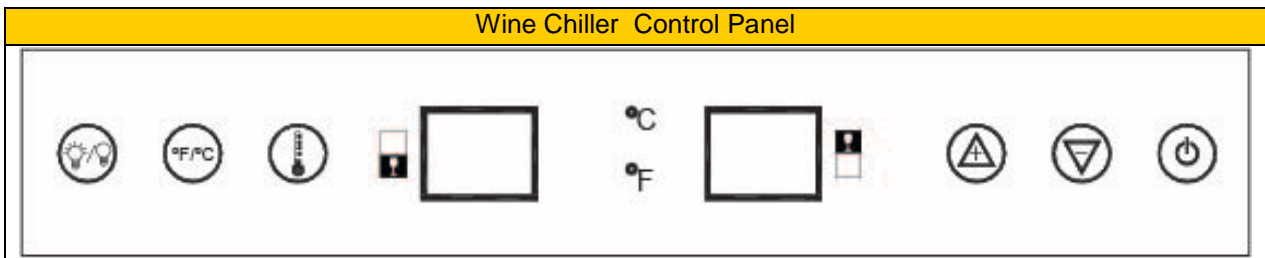


OPERATING YOUR WINE CHILLER

It is recommended you install the appliance in a place where the ambient temperature is between 72-78 degrees Fahrenheit. If the ambient temperature is above or below recommended temperatures, the performance of the unit may be affected. For example, placing your unit in extreme cold or hot conditions may cause interior temperatures to fluctuate. The range of 40-65 degrees Fahrenheit may not be reached. Your wine chiller is designed to operate with at a range of 40° - 65° F (5 – 18°C). Temperature range for the upper zone is 40°-56°F (4°-13°C) and 54°-65°F (12°-18°C) in the lower zone.

Recommended Temperatures for Chilling Wine.

Red Wines	58 - 65 °F	14 - 18 °C		Rose Wines	49 - 51 °F	9 - 11 °C
Dry / White Wines	48 - 57 °F	10 - 13 °C		Sparkling Wines	40 - 47 °F	5 - 8 °C



You can select temperature display setting from Fahrenheit to Celsius degree by pushing the **°F/°C** button/mark. Fahrenheit or Celsius degrees indicator will appear in green color in the temperature display window.

➤ **ON/OFF POWER**

To turn ON or OFF the appliance, press the button/mark and hold for **3** seconds.

➤ **SETTING THE TEMPERATURE CONTROL**

First press the button, the display for the lower zone will flash indicating that you are setting the temperature for the lower zone, press again the display for the upper zone will flash indicating that you are setting the temperature for the upper zone.

The numbers in the display window will flash, You can press and buttons/marks to control the internal temperature .

The degrees indicators will appear in the display window.

The temperature that you desire to set will increase 1°F or 1°C if you push the button/mark once, on the contrary the temperature will decrease 1°F or 1°C if you push the button/mark once.

NOTE:





- If the unit is unplugged, power lost, or turned off, you must wait 3 to 5 minutes before restarting the unit. If you attempt to restart before this time delay, the Wine Chiller will not start.
- When you use the wine chiller for the first time or restart the wine chiller after having been shut off for a long time, there could be a few degrees variance between the temperature you select and the one indicated on the LED readout. This is normal and it is due to the length of the activation time. Once the wine chiller is running for a few hours everything will be back to normal.

➤ **STORAGE**

Many bottles may differ in size and dimensions. As such the actual number of bottles you may be able to store may vary.

NOTE: Capacity: Bottle capacities are approximate maximums when storing traditional Bordeaux 750 ML bottles and include bulk storage.

➤ **INTERIOR LIGHT**

- Interior lights are available in both upper and lower zones.
- You can turn the interior light on in each zone by pushing the button marked with the “bulb” symbol  or touch the mark .
- The lights will turn off automatically if it remains ON for 10 minutes or more. You have to push the button marked with the “bulb” symbol  or touch the mark  again and the light will turn back on.

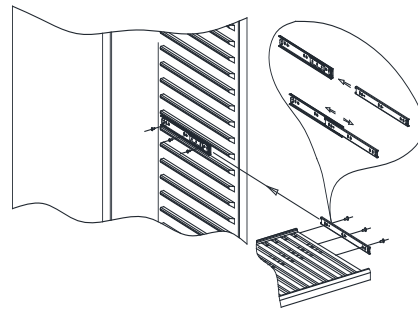
➤ **DOOR LOCK**

Your unit is provided with a lock and key combination.

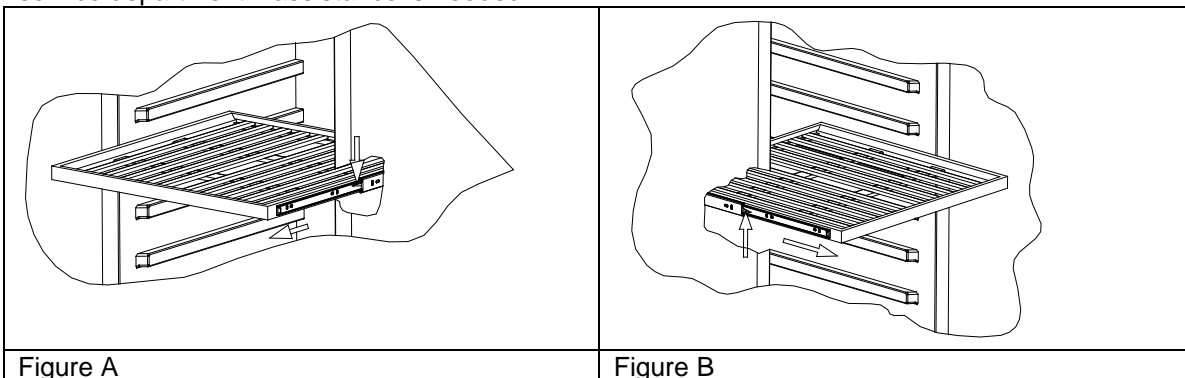
The keys are located inside the plastic bag that contains the User’s Guide. Insert the key into the lock and turn it counterclockwise to **unlock** the door. To lock the door do the reverse operation making sure metal pin is engaged completely. Remove the key and place it in a secure place for safekeeping.

Pull-out Roller Shelves

- To prevent damaging the door gasket, make sure to have the door all the way opened when pulling shelves out of the rail compartment.
- For easy access to the bottles, you must pull the shelves approximately 1/3 out of the rail compartment.



- To remove the shelves out of the rail pull each shelf approximately 1/3 out. Use a long flat screwdriver to press down the right plastic notch as shown in Figure A and at the same time lift the left plastic notch as shown in Figure B. Then proceed to pull out the shelf slowly. Contact our service department if assistance is needed.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

➤ CLEANING YOUR WINE CHILLER

- Turn off the power, unplug the appliance, and remove all items including shelves.
- Wash the inside surfaces with a warm water and baking soda solution. The solution should be about 2 tablespoons of baking soda to a quart of water.
- Wash the shelves with a mild detergent solution.
- Wring excess water out of the sponge or cloth when cleaning area of the controls, or any electrical parts.
- Wash the outside cabinet with warm water and mild liquid detergent. Rinse well and wipe dry with a clean soft cloth.
- Do not use steel wool or steel brush on the stainless steel. These will contaminate the stainless steel with steel particles and rusting may occur.

➤ POWER FAILURE

- Most power failures are corrected within a few hours and should not affect the temperature of your appliance if you minimize the number of times the door is opened. If the power is going to be off for a longer period of time, you need to take the proper steps to protect your contents.

➤ MOVING YOUR WINE CHILLER

- Remove all items.
- Securely tape down all loose items (shelves) inside your appliance.
- Tape the door shut.
- Be sure the appliance stays secure in the upright position during transportation. Also protect outside of appliance with a blanket, or similar item.

➤ ENERGY SAVING TIPS

- The Wine Chiller should be located in the coolest area of the room, away from heat producing appliances, and out of the direct sunlight.

CHARCOAL FILTRATION SYSTEM

Your wine is a living object that breathes through the cork of its bottle. In order to preserve the quality and taste of your fine wines, they must be stored at the ideal temperature and ambient conditions.

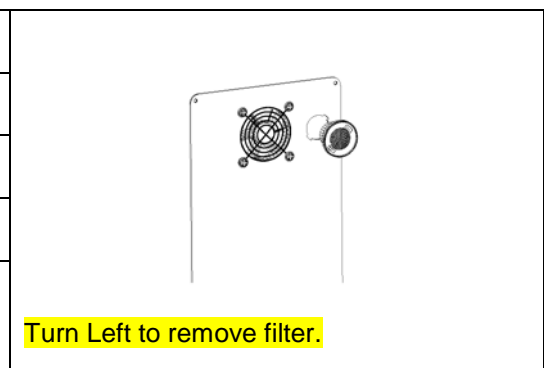
Your cellar is equipped with an active charcoal filtration system to ensure air purity, cooling efficiency, and to maintain an odor free cabinet for the storage of your fine wines. The filter assembly is located at the rear panel inside your cellar.

Keep in mind, that this filter must be changed every 12 months.

To purchase replacement filters, call our Parts / Service Department at 1 – 800 – 220 – 5570.

To replace your filter:

1	Remove the bottles of wine stored on the two (2) shelves in front of the filter.
2	Remove the shelves and set aside to be replaced once you have changed the filter
3	Hold the filter and turn it at 45 degrees in the counter-clockwise direction and then pull it out.
4	Remove the existing filter and replace with a new one.
5	Put the new filter into the hole and then turn the filter at 45 degrees in clockwise direction.



PROBLEMS WITH YOUR WINE CHILLER?

You can solve many common Wine Chiller problems easily, saving you the cost of a possible service call. Try the suggestions below to see if you can solve the problem before calling the servicer.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE
Wine Chiller does not operate.	Not plugged in. The appliance is turned off. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse.
Wine Chiller is not cold enough.	Check the temperature control setting. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.
Turns on and off frequently.	The room temperature is hotter than normal. A large amount of contents has been added to the wine chiller. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The temperature control is not set correctly. The door gasket does not seal properly.
The light does not work.	Not plugged in. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse. The light button is turned off.
Vibrations.	Check to assure that the Wine Chiller is level.
The Wine Chiller seems to make too much noise.	The rattling noise may come from the flow of the refrigerant, which is normal. As each cycle ends, you may hear gurgling sounds caused by the flow of refrigerant in your Wine Chiller. Contraction and expansion of the inside walls may cause popping and crackling noises. The Wine Chiller is not level.
The door will not close properly.	The door is misaligned. The Wine Chiller is not level. The gasket is dirty. The shelves are out of position.
Display flashes Error message "E1" or "E2"	Temperature sensor UPPER ZONE failure. Contact the Avanti Service Department – 1 - 800 – 220 - 5570
Display flashes Error message "E3" or "E4"	Defrost sensor (Coil Sensor) failure. Contact the Avanti Service Department – 1 - 800 – 220 – 5570
Display flashes Error message "E7" or "E8"	Temperature sensor LOWER ZONE failure. Contact the Avanti Service Department – 1 - 800 – 220 – 5570
Display flashes Error message "HH"	High temperature alarm (over 78.8°F/26°C) Contact the Avanti Service Department – 1 - 800 – 220 – 5570
Display flashes Error message "LL"	Low temperature alarm (below 32°F/0°C) Contact the Avanti Service Department – 1 - 800 – 220 – 5570

ATENCION

INSTRUCCIONES PARA LA CONEXION A TIERRA

Este aparato electrodoméstico debe estar conectado a tierra. En caso de un cortocircuito eléctrico, la conexión a tierra reduce el riesgo de choque eléctrico proporcionando un cable a tierra con una enchufe de conexión a tierra. Este enchufe debe estar conectado en un tomacorriente instalado correctamente y conectado a tierra.

INSTRUCCIONES DE INSTALACION

Saque los embalajes exteriores, limpie bien el exterior con un paño suave seco, y el interior con un paño húmedo y tibio. Evite colocar la vinera cerca de una fuente de calor, luz de sol directa, o lugar húmedo.

Ubicación

1. Seleccione un lugar con su piso fuerte y nivelado.
2. Evite la luz directa del sol o calor. La luz directa del sol puede afectar la capa de acrílico. Las fuentes de calor en su proximidad provocarán un consumo mayor de electricidad.

OPERACION

Para evitar vibraciones, la unidad debe estar bien nivelada. La temperatura variará dependiendo de la cantidad de botellas almacenadas y la frecuencia con que se abre la puerta.

Cuando la vinera no se use por un período largo, desconecte el enchufe y deje la puerta entreabierta.

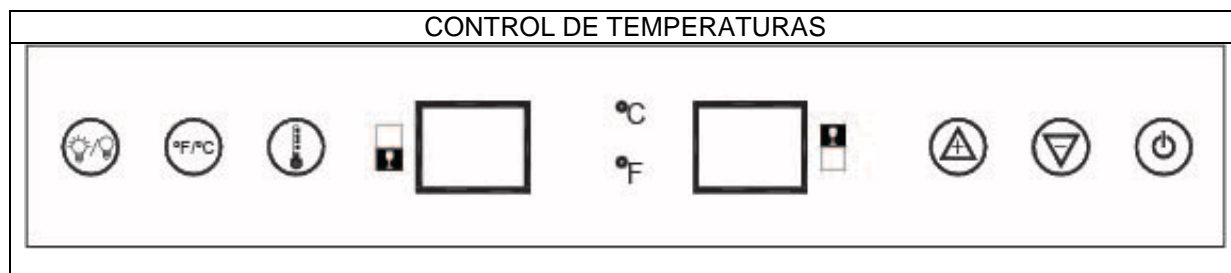
Nota: Espere entre 3 a 5 minutos antes de volver a encender si el funcionamiento ha sido interrumpido.

Se recomienda que Ud coloque su vinera en un lugar donde la temperatura ambiental se mantenga entre 23-25 grados centígrados.







ENCENDIDO/APAGADO



Para apagar el refrigerador de vino, presione el botón () y manténgalo oprimido por un mínimo de 3 segundos.

 Ud. puede seleccionar los grados centigrados o Fahrenheit presionando el botón marcado . En la pantalla digital aparecerá el F o C indicador en color verde.


Operación

Oprima el botón marcado  una vez, los números en la pantalla digital para la zona inferior titilarán indicando que este programando la temperatura de la zona inferior, oprima una vez más y los números de la pantalla digital para la zona superior titilarán indicando que este programando la temperatura de la zona superior.

Oprima los botones marcado “  ” y “  ” localizados en el panel de controles para programar la temperatura. Al oprimir los botones marcados “  ” o “  ” por primera vez, el indicador en la pantalla mostrará la temperatura programada de fábrica o la más reciente.

Oprima el botón marcado () una vez y la temperatura aumentará un grado. Si Ud oprime el botón marcado () una vez la temperatura bajará un grado.

Luz interior

La luz interior se controla manualmente y no funciona al abrir ni cerrar la puerta. Para prender o apagar la luz, presione el boton marcado () de la luz ubicado en el panel de control.

Cerradura de la puerta

Su unidad viene equipada con una combinación de cerradura y llave.

Las llaves (2) están dentro de la bolsa plástica junto al manual de instrucciones.

Introduzca la llave en la cerradura y gírela hacia la izquierda para abrir la puerta.

Para cerrarla, gire la llave hacia la derecha.

Quite la llave y colóquela en un lugar seguro para evitar que se pierda.

Descongelación

Su vinera ha sido diseñada con un sistema de descongelación de “ciclo automático”.

Las superficies refrigeradas del compartimiento para vinos se descongela automáticamente, durante el ciclo “apagado” del control de enfriamiento (termostato). El agua descongelada del compartimiento es eliminada automáticamente, encauzándola hacia una bandeja de goteo ubicada en el compresor. La transferencia de calor del compresor evapora el agua.

ADVERTENCIA

Asegúrese de tener la puerta abierta completamente si Ud desea remover las repisas o moverlas hacia adelante para extraer una botella.

CUIDADO Y MANTENIMIENTO

Limpieza

Para limpiar el interior, use un paño suave con una solución de una cucharada de bicarbonato de sodio por cada cuarto de agua, o una solución de espuma de jabón suave, o un detergente suave. Para lavar las rejillas, sáquelas deslizándolas con cuidado, y use una solución de detergente suave; luego séquelas con un paño suave. Limpie el exterior con un paño húmedo suave y un poco de detergente suave o productos de limpieza para electrodomésticos.

Período de vacaciones

Para períodos cortos de vacaciones, deje los controles en la posición normal. Durante ausencias más largas;

- (a) saque todas las botellas,
- (b) desconecte la vinera del tomacorriente,
- (c) limpie bien el refrigerador para vinos,
- (d) deje la puerta abierta para evitar la formación de condensación, moho u olores.

Corte de corriente

La mayoría de los cortes de corriente se corrigen en una o dos horas y no afectarán las temperaturas de su vinera. Sin embargo, Ud. deberá reducir la cantidad de veces que abra la puerta cuando la corriente esté apagada.

Si Ud. se muda

Saque o asegure todos los artículos dentro de su vinera. Para evitar que los tornillos nivelantes se averíen, gírelos completamente hacia la base.

Algunas reglas importantes para el uso correcto de la vinera.

- Las bebidas se deben guardar en botellas cerradas.
- No sobrecargue el compartimiento interior.
- No abra la puerta a menos que sea necesario.
- Si la vinera se guardará sin uso por períodos largos, se sugiere que, luego de una limpieza cuidadosa, se deje la puerta entreabierta para permitir que el aire circule dentro de la caja y evitar una posible formación de condensación, moho u olores.
- Nunca cubra los estantes del compartimiento para vinos con papel de aluminio o cualquier otro material para cubrir estantes que puedan obstruir la circulación del aire.
